Eligibility Criteria

Hold a Master's degree or be an engineer in a field related to Natural Sciences or Social Sciences. Alternatively, candidates with a higher education diploma may apply if they have at least three years of relevant professional or personal experience in artisanal mariculture.

Earn an International Certificate

The IH.S.M of the University of Toliara
The University of Liège

Study Requirements

Theoretical and practical courses are conducted entirely in English; a high level of English proficiency is required.

Selected candidates may benefit from financial support depending on their country of origin. For applicants from African countries—particularly those supported by ARES—international travel expenses and a scholarship covering accommodation and living costs in Toliara may be fully or partially covered.

Applicants from developed countries are required to cover their own international travel costs, accommodation and living expenses in Toliara (training location), as well as the registration fees

Your application must include: CV, Cover Letter, scanned copy of your diploma.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview in English on April 24, 2026.
